Technical Publicity and Communication

With the help of these sub-committees the website and rebranding has been refreshed. Policy development and updates have commenced and is a work in progress. Technical officials' development continues to see growth in our qualified officials that enthusiastically support the Clubs/Region/NZ. Our Regional swim meets were exceptionally well run with positive and constructive feedback received to improve on future events. Regrettably the dramatic COVID induced pause meant the Region had to cancel the St George Shield and Annual Prize-Giving, as well, most of the regions swimmers were unable to compete at their 2020 pinnacle meets which included the Olympic Trails. The Junior Festival managed to sneak in before the COVID restrictions and we are pleased to confirm our swimmers performed admirably.

The Board completed a submission to the Howick Local Board with respect to the planned Flat Bush Aquatic and Leisure Centre. Many thanks to Alastair Bates for driving the presentation which has resulted in the local council strongly supporting a 50m lap pool with 2m deep water. Final outcome is still some time away.

Results achieved by the members in our region are worth celebrating: International and National success, NZ Records, SNZ SC Opens saw two Clubs ranked top ten in NZ (HPK & PSC). SNZ Open Water saw PSC take top club honours. Junior Festival resulted in Papatoetoe achieving national winner status in the 51-100 swimmer category and Manurewa achieved 1st in the Harlequin zone in their category. The inability of SNZ to host Age Groups, Div2 and NZ Opens was devastating for our swimmers that had been preparing/training for months if not years. I have no doubt that if these events had gone ahead SCM swimmers would have made us proud.

My sincere thanks to everyone that has assisted the region with a special mention to Sandra Harnett our administrator who has steadfastly supported the Region and the Board over many years. We also have many wonderful volunteers, a number of which are long-term supporters that selflessly give of their time, energy and expertise. We cannot function successfully without them to lighten the load (and the cost). While it is pleasing to note the region is in a comfortable financial position, the coming seasons will be tough. Access to funding assistance will be limited if not impossible to source which may see the need to dip into reserves. As we now focus on the future, we need your help more than ever to ensure SCM continues to thrive and has the capacity to provide appropriate opportunities for all our members. With this is mind discussions have started with Swimming Waikato to see how the regions can work together smarter. We are looking forward to working with you over the course of this coming season and I wish you all every success as you strive to achieve your goals.

Through the troublesome times, we, the Committee have kept in constant communication with each other. Events Sub-Committee 2019/2020 AGM Report

Sub-committee formed and first met in Oct 2019 – tasked with creating & running upcoming SCM regional events and to assist any club with meets as required. SC to start with SCM Anniversary Meet in Dec then Age Group Champs in January. Jo Clare appointed as Sub-Committee Chair by Board Member Ligi Asiata and agreed by ESC members Sarah, Cindy, Rhonda, Minoo & Geoff (resigned from ESC in January).

1. SCM Junior SC Champs - Oct 2019

Not run by ESC – was already in place due to timing.

Results:

18 Teams

194 Swimmers

920 Entries

2. Anniversary Meet - Dec 2019

Meet feedback from some clubs was fantastic – couple of small issues that arose which were either dealt with as they occurred or shortly after the meet was held - mainly around organizational points and a H&S incident at the end of the meet.

Cindy sourced Council Gazebo's and seats for use - and a vehicle to move all required equipment from PPT to PPK.

Duty Clubs - PPK & MRE

Results:

15 Teams

186 Swimmers

733 Entries

3. Age Group Champs - Jan 2020

Decision was made to move food area away from pool side decking and exit doors to comply with H&S regs from PPT pool. Updated site map sent to all clubs. A new speaker was purchased for the starting system. New laptop purchased and Meet Manager uploaded. Meet set up imported from Geoff's system to new laptop to run results. Issue arose at meet with cables not working with old Colorado timing system. Minoo tasked with sourcing new cable for laptop-Colorado connection. Rhonda worked AOD with Minoo to gain experience. Complaint regarding printing of relays on prog – Grand relay only showed first 4 names not the whole team – PPT missed sending enough swimmers causing DQ.

Duty Clubs – PPT, FST, PUK, HPK

Results:

22 Teams – 2 International

311 Swimmers

1780 Entries

4. St Georges Meet – June 2020

Cancelled due to COVID-19

5. Winter & Dolphin Leagues

Feedback from coaches meeting to see a different type of event format offered – minimum 2 development meets like a level 3 meet (results not approved ok), 2-3 hours long, 25/50/100 m races, training ground for new swimmers and officials, maybe fun relays at end.

Discussions held around timing – mid-winter/not on a Rugby night/5pm starts – everything shelved

for 2020 with the disruption of COVID-19. To be reviewed for 2020/2021 year.

6. SCM Junior Festival – Oct 2020

Venue @ Dio School. No food allowed on pool deck – SCM has now adopted a snack bag food policy - no shared food trays. Own water bottles to be supplied by officials and topped up when required.

MEDALS – PROPOSED CHANGE that medals will not be used at this meet – only time buster ribbons – changing from CHAMPS to Festival – juniors have medals at Age Group Champs. TBC at Board Meeting

7. Anniversary Meet - 2020

Pool bookings have been cancelled – there are too many clashes with AK meets & unable to secure dates at Waterworld in Waikato to suit – especially now with meets being changed around by other regions after COVID. Decision to not run Anniversary this coming season has been made.

8. SCM Long Distance Champs – Feb 2021

Proposal to be voted on – have an integrated SCM LD meet series – swimmers must swim at these meets to qualify for SCM results – clubs can use as their own LD champs but if they run a separate meet to this – those times will not be eligible for SCM LD Champs results. Request for pool booking availability has been made – confirmation of venues TBC after further discussions and SCM Board agreement.

- 9. Sarah Menzies tendered her resignation from SCM Events SC in May 2020 due to changes in her work and PSC commitments. Reply sent thanking her for her contribution. Cindy Hickmott's son has also retired from swimming but Cindy is happy to stay on ESC at this time.
- 10. Equipment Wish List for upcoming season

Upgrade existing white tents to 30 Ezi-up gazebos: 18 start/refs/8 turn/4 Marshalling 80 Chairs – interconnectable with no arms

3 Trestle tables – 2 large, 1 small for refs area

Portable barriers – tiger tails that loop over cones to block off no-go areas

Timing Button Holders – have sourced and collected from AK Swimming – some repairs may be required if want to use sets at both ends of pool.

Medal supply & budget to be discussed – inc SCM Juniors in Oct. Pool hire costs/budgets to be discussed.
